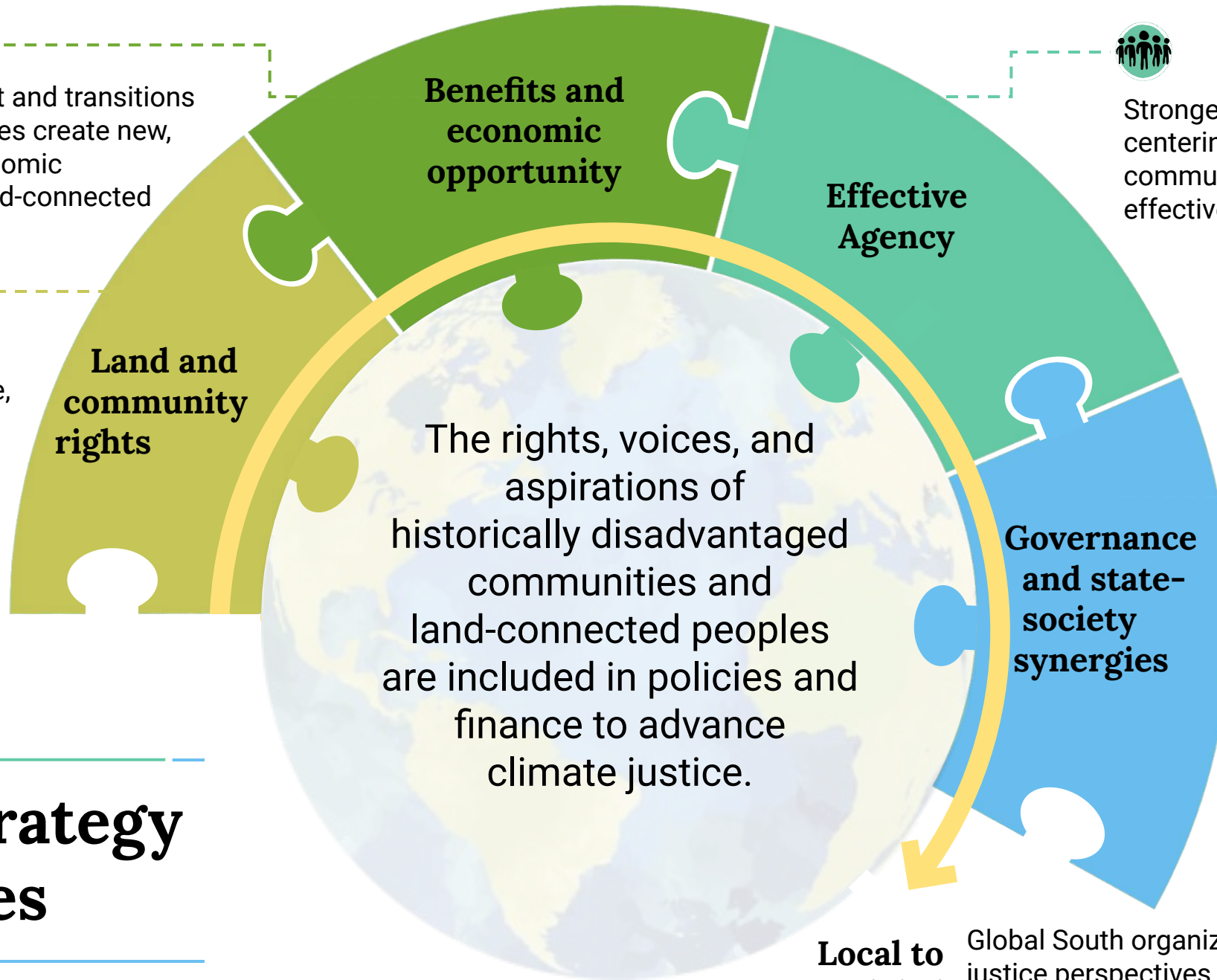
Fossil fuel phase-out and transitions to new energy sources create new, more equitable economic opportunities for land-connected communities.
